Presents the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA), headquartered in Springfield. Provides a directory of agency and regional contacts. Explains that IEMA is responsible for coordinating activities in Illinois that concern programs for disaster mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery a calendar of training and events, along with information about IEMA and search and rescue programs. Offers access to fact sheets about floods, and thunderstorms. Contains photographic images of disasters, as well as games and information for children.
